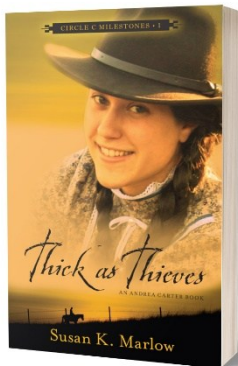

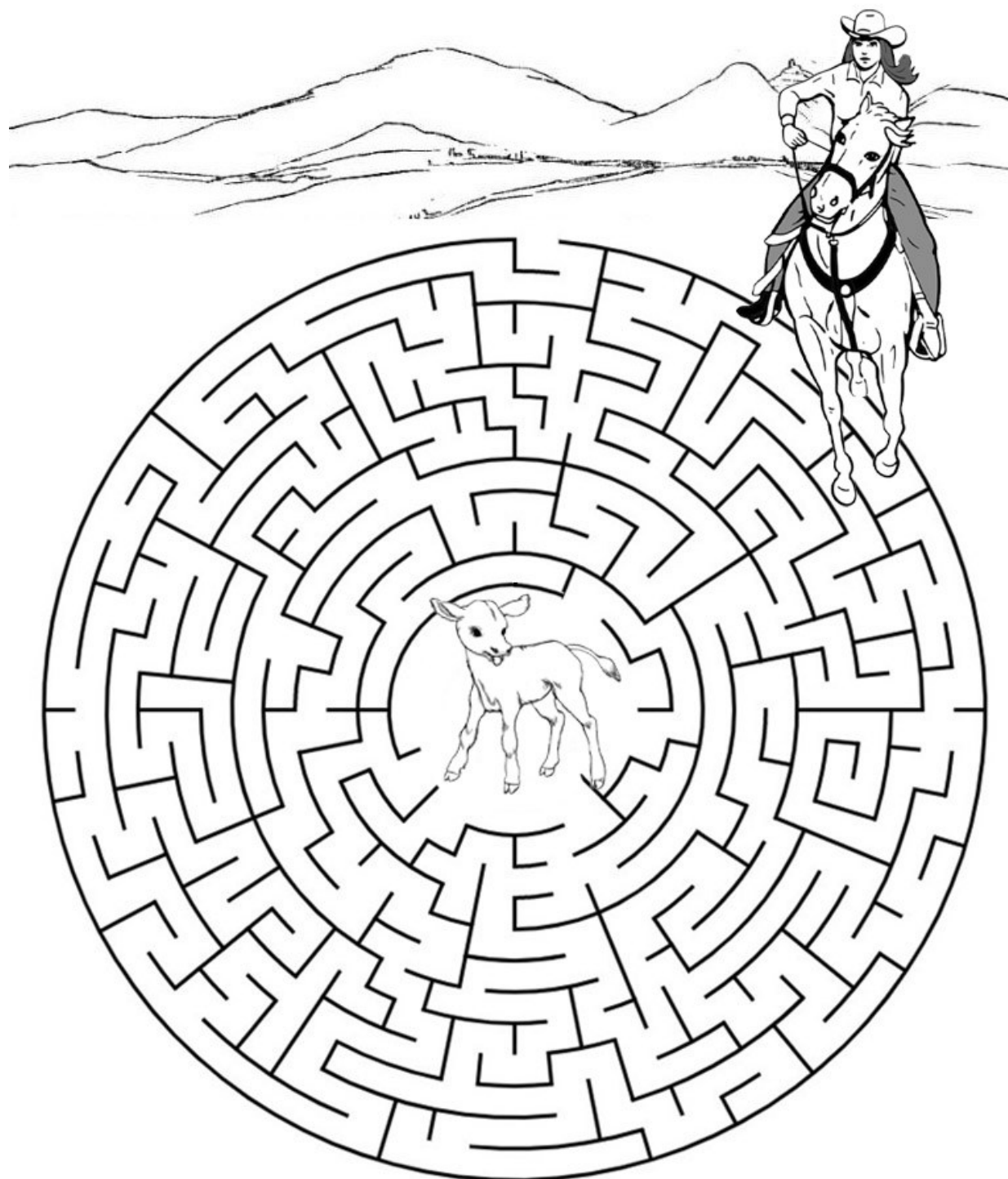

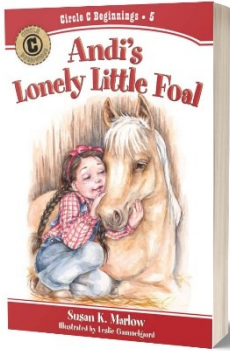




A LOST CALF

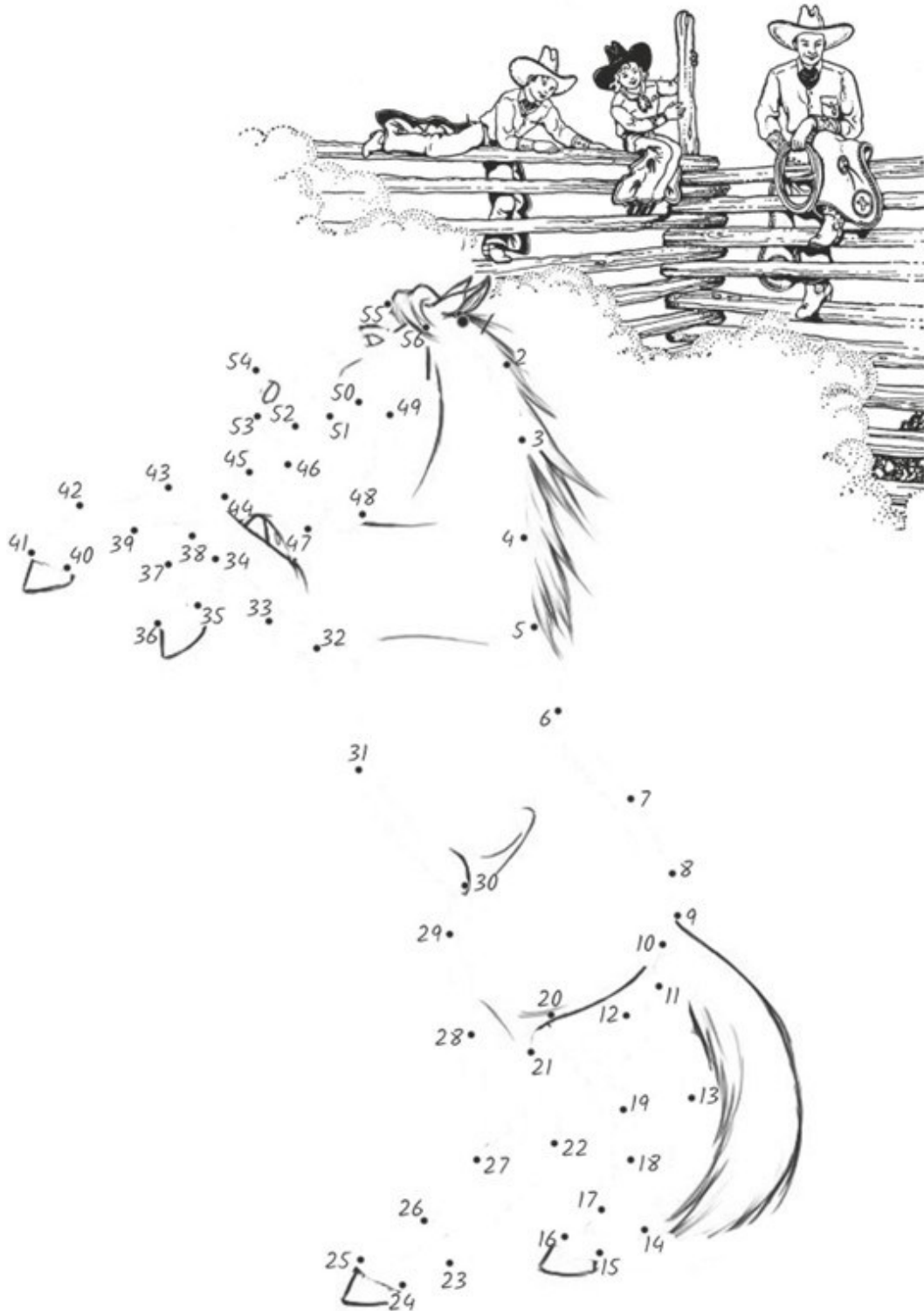

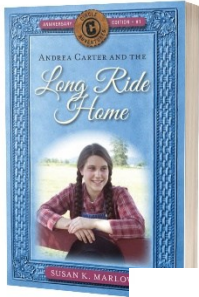




A WILD STALLION

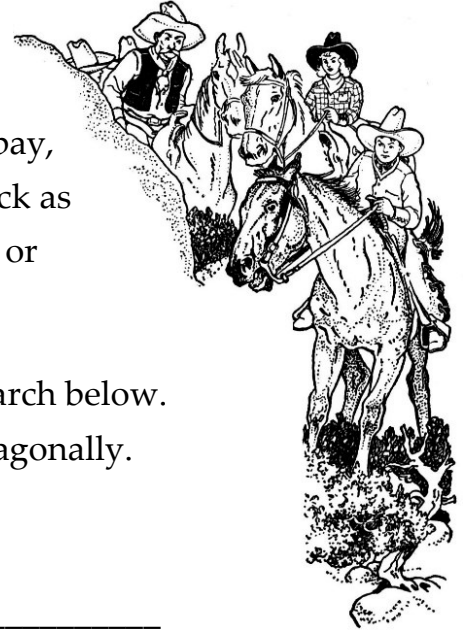


A HORSE OF A DIFFERENT COLOR

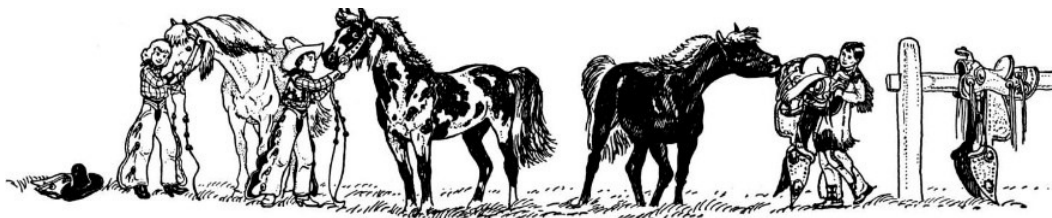
Find fifteen (15) horse colors and combinations in the word search below. Words run forward, backward, vertically, horizontally, and diagonally. (See the solution on the last page.)

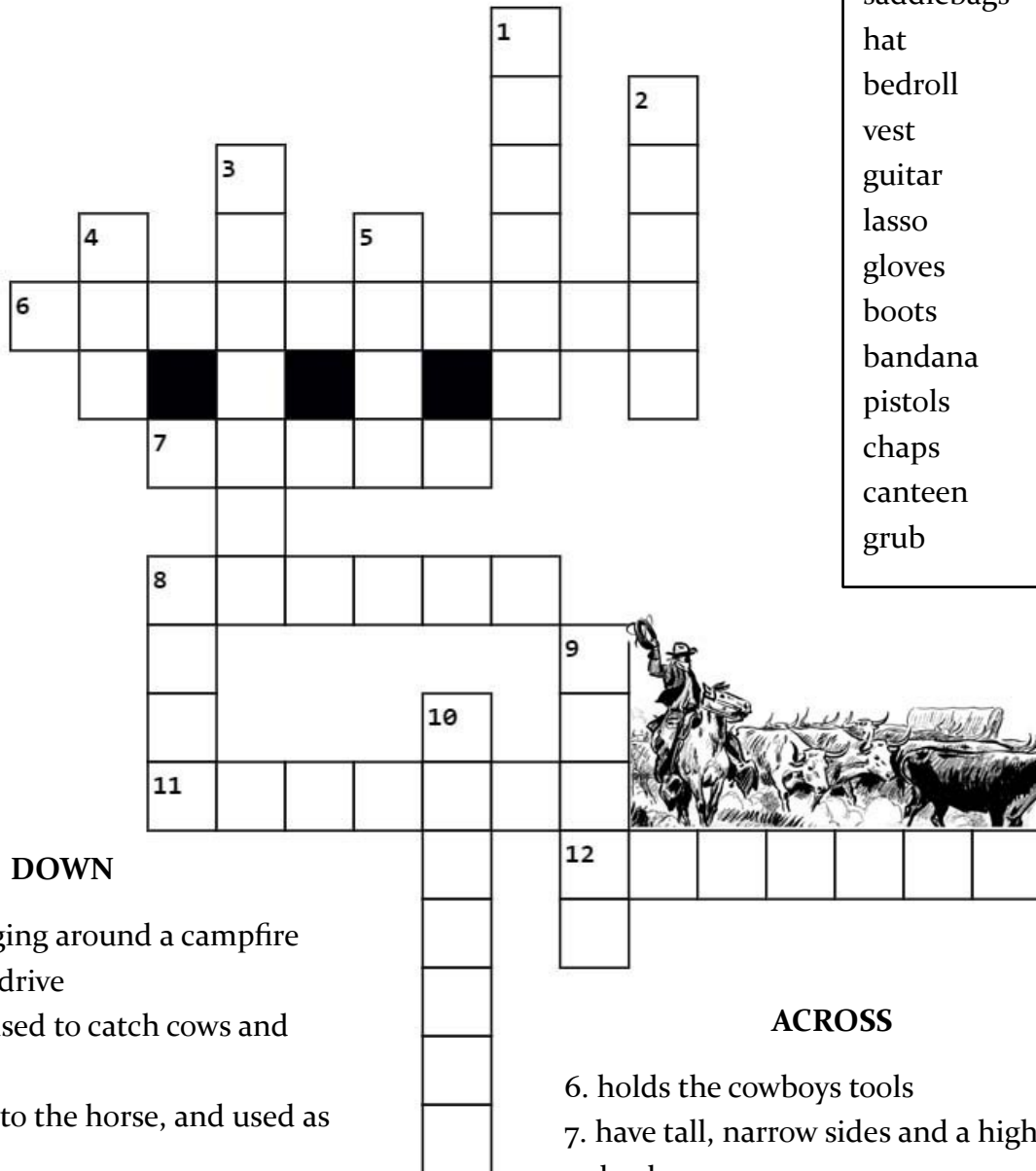
A COWBOY CROSSWORD PUZZLE

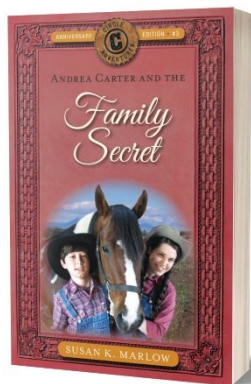
DOWN

ANDI'S SUGAR COOKIES WITH A CHOCOLATE "TWIST"

Andi's family has been making these special sugar cookies for years. One day when Melinda was mixing up a batch of these light and delicious treats, Andi was shaving chocolate for a cup of hot chocolate (she loves to dip the cookies in hot cocoa). She was so busy shaving and watching her sister at the same time, that a handful of chocolate shavings ended up in the sugar cookie dough. Since there is plenty of white sugar in the dough, Melinda told Andi it was all right and not to fret that the bitter chocolate shavings might ruin the cookies. Then Melinda went "all out" and added even more shavings. The new sugar cookies turned out delicious! Here is the updated recipe, using mini-chocolate chips. Try it!



Preheat the oven to 375 degrees.

Makes about two dozen cookies.

INGREDIENTS:

1 cup butter, softened

½ cup powdered sugar

½ white sugar

1 egg

½ teaspoon vanilla extract

½ teaspoon almond extract

2 cups white flour

ANDI'S SUGAR COOKIES

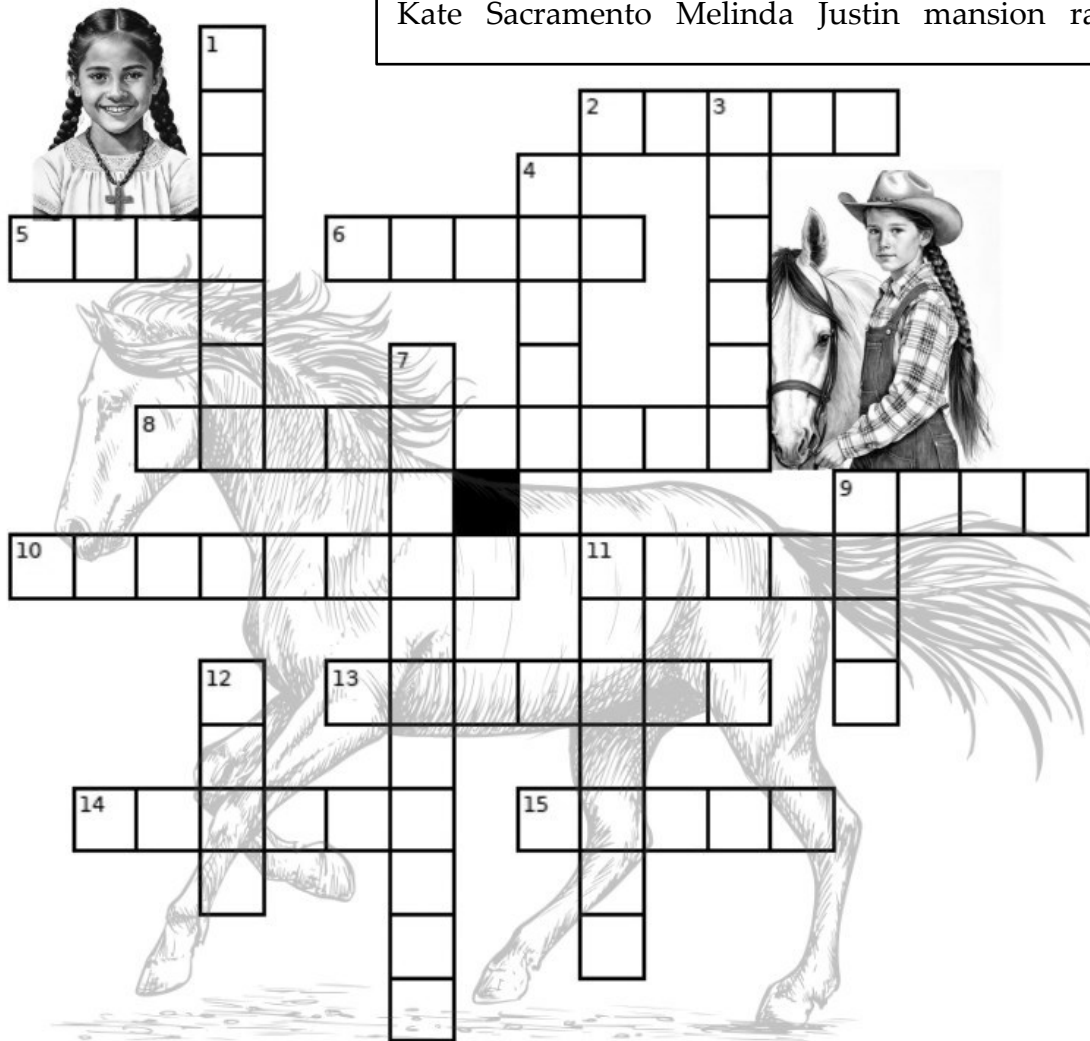
INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Beat the butter, white sugar, and powdered sugar together until smooth and creamy.
2. Add the egg, vanilla, and almond extract and beat.
3. Mix in the flour, baking soda, and cream of tartar by hand.
4. Add the cup of mini chocolate chips and mix until the dough forms a ball.
5. Roll pieces of dough into balls (flour your hands) about 1 ½ inches in diameter and place two inches apart on an ungreased cookie sheet.
6. Dip the bottom of a glass in sugar and press the dough balls until slightly flattened.
7. Bake for 7-9 minutes at 375° until light brown around the edges. *Do not overbake!*
8. Cool on a cookie rack or paper towels.

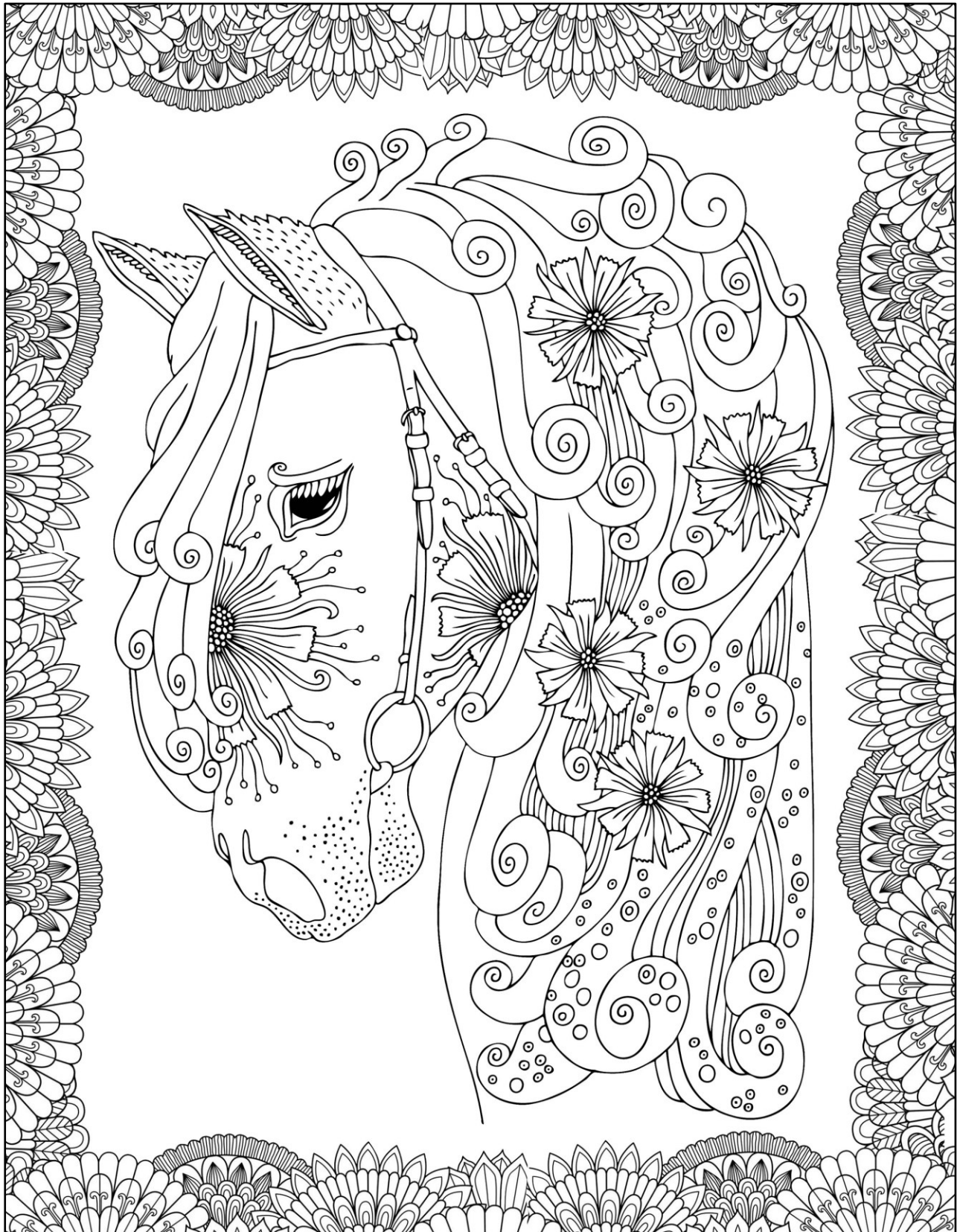

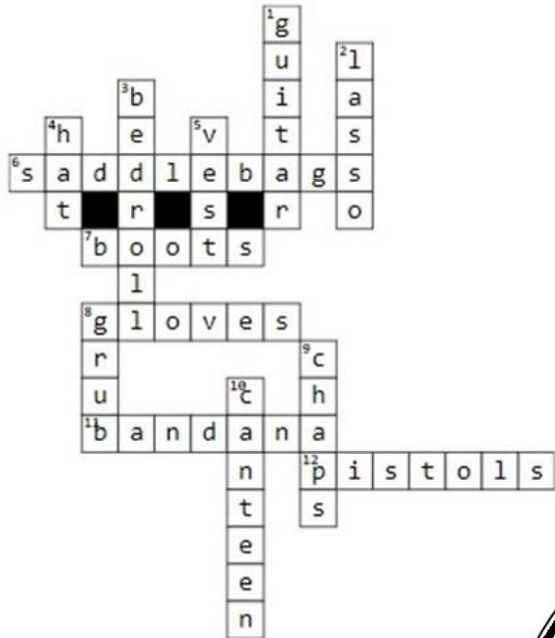
AN ELEGANT EQUINE TO COLOR

Here is a "horse of a different color." Or a horse of *many* different colors. Whatever colors she is, this mare is an elegant equine.

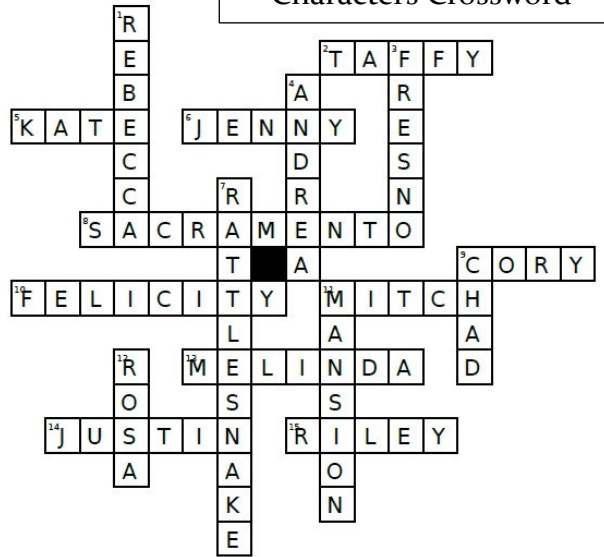
